

## What is Weatherization and is it really free?

Community Services Consortium (CSC), in partnership with local utility companies, provides **free weatherization services** to low-income homeowners and renters in Linn, Benton, and Lincoln Counties.

Weatherization measures help reduce energy bills by making homes more energy efficient and **may include:**

- home evaluation and energy education
- home ventilation fan
- LED light bulbs
- attic, floor, or wall insulation
- windows (occasionally)
- weather stripping around doors
- sealing gaps around pipes going through the ceiling or floor
- sealing heat ducts
- furnace evaluation
- minor repairs related to weatherization

Most weatherization measures are completed by our in-house crews. Job costs are paid for with funding from federal and state grants, as well as local utility companies.

## How do I sign up?

**1. Check the income chart at the right.** Are you below our income limits?

**2. Complete a Weatherization Application.**

**3. Mail your application to**

**4. Wait List**

When approved, you will be notified and your name will go on our Wait List. When it is your turn, we will check your household income and make sure we have all the required information.

**5. Your Turn!**

Our Weatherization Auditor will contact you to set up a time to come to your home. He will inspect it and run tests to determine what weatherization measures we are able to install.

## Who is eligible for Weatherization services?

Homeowners and renters in Linn, Benton, or Lincoln County whose **gross household income (before deductions)** is below the following income limits are eligible.



We weatherize mobile homes as well as houses.

## What are the benefits of weatherizing my home?

Weatherization makes you more comfortable by keeping your home warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.

While everyone's home is different, it's possible for a typical household to save \$300 or more a year in energy costs through weatherization.

While you're waiting for your home to be weatherized, try these no-cost energy saving tips:

- Lower the thermostat and dress warmer. Turn your thermostat down at night and whenever the house is not occupied. Try 68°F during the day and 60°F at night.
- Lower the temperature on your *electric* water heater to 120° F. Turn it off when leaving for long periods of time.
- Take short showers instead of baths.
- Wash full loads of clothes; use warm or cold water to wash, cold water to rinse.
- Clean dryer lint filter after every use.
- Use kitchen and bath fans to reduce moisture and mold, but turn them off when they have done the job.
- Turn off lights, computers and other electronic appliances when not in use.
