

# YouthBuild Interest Application

YouthBuild is a program that helps young adults (ages 17-24) in Linn County gain construction skills, earn industry credentials, and prepare for their GED tests. YouthBuild Crew Members generally serve between 6-12 months and earn weekly incentives (over \$200, depending on attendance and performance) while getting hands-on work experience. Throughout the program Crew Members also receive support to increase work-readiness and life-skills and move toward self-sufficiency. After completing all service hours, crew members will receive an award of \$1,527 to use toward further education.
