HOUSING

We have been working nonstop to help keep our community safe and housed during this pandemic. Between federal CARES Act funding, and emergency relief funds allocated by the state, CSC has received over **\$4 million** to help those in Linn, Benton and Lincoln counties financially impacted by COVID-19. So far, we have helped **166 households** and allocated over **\$500,000 in COVID rental assistance. Click here** to apply.

UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Our Utility Assistance program has received over **\$1.5 million** of federal COVID-relief funding to assist community members with their utilities. This additional money will allow us to serve more people than before the pandemic, including community members who already received assistance from CSC over the winter. LINN BENTON FOOD SHARE

Linn Benton Food Share has provided over 100,000 pounds of food per week to Linn and Benton counties since the pandemic began. We have supplied our member agencies and meal sites with enough food for over 32,500 meals and 3,400 food boxes - enough to serve over 9,700 people each week. HEAD START

While closed to the public, we shared over **50** educational videos from our Head Start staff for parents and kiddos. To prepare for the upcoming school year, we received **\$240,000** to aid with implementing new COVID precautions and equipment, and support staff.
