- ✓ Collaborating with partners in Linn and Marion counties to create youth crews to help with cleanup



## COMING TOGETHER TO HELP

The **Workforce & Education** department has stationed multiple full-time employees at resource and donation sites, and is hiring local wildfire victims to help this effort.

Our **Housing** department is helping those who lost homes with rental assistance and providing referrals to other community resources

**Linn Benton Food Share** provided food boxes and made food donations to the Linn and Benton County fairgrounds relief centers.

**Career Tech Charter High** is helping Lincoln City families enrolled at the school impacted by the wildfires access internet and technology for virtual education.

Our **Housing** department is collaborating with CHANCE to fund safe, temporary shelter for homeless individuals and wildfire victims

**Head Start** in Lincoln County is partnering with Chapel by the Sea, housing and helping 2 families who lost their homes.
