**Do you need help paying your monthly City Services bill?** The City of Corvallis is enrolling customers in a new assistance program to help community members pay their City Services bills.

The program will provide eligible customers with a credit of up to \$25 to be applied to their monthly City Services bills.

\*Eligibility is determined based on household income. This is a new program, so the exact amount of credit will not be known until the number of applicants who have applied is verified. Applicants will need to show proof of eligibility through enrollment in either the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Oregon Health Plan (OHP), or the free/reduced school lunch program through the Corvallis School District. This is an annual program and must be renewed each year by submitting a new application.
