
## POINT IN TIME COUNT REMINDERS



- If you don't feel safe approaching someone or going somewhere, don't.
  - ✓ Always lead with respect for the person and their dignity.
  - ✓ Wear sturdy shoes with weather-appropriate clothing.
- ✓ Bring a fully charged cell phone or other mobile device and charger (a battery bank is ideal).

## CONTACT:

"We're doing a survey on housing, where did you sleep last night?"

SHOULD YOU SURVEY? If they are outside, in a tent, car, RV without utilities, shed or other building without utilities.

YES

If they are in a shelter, the shelter will count shelter guests, thank them for their time.

NO

If they are unstably housed (doubled up, living in motel they pay for, at-risk of losing housing)

NO

Whether you survey them or not, always thank them for their time.
